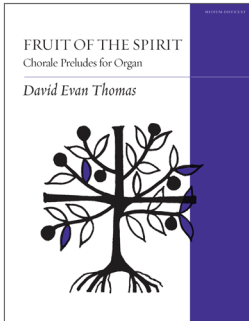


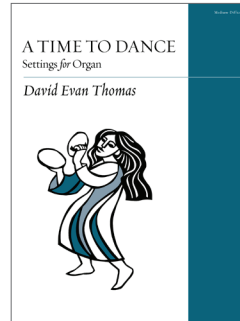

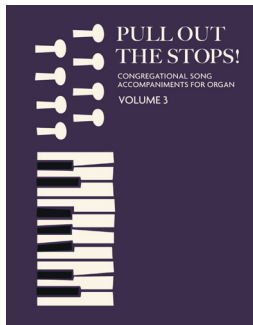
**Fruit of the Spirit:

This simple concept—write a hymn setting based on each of the fruits of the Spirit from Galatians—has led to this collection of deeply imaginative settings for organ.



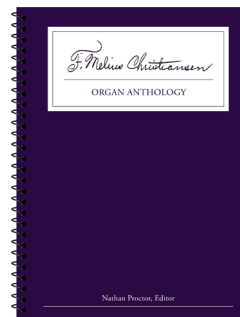
**A Time to Dance:

This exciting collection by David Evan Thomas features seven familiar tunes expressed in historical dance genres, along with three original pieces that include a sicilienne and minuet.



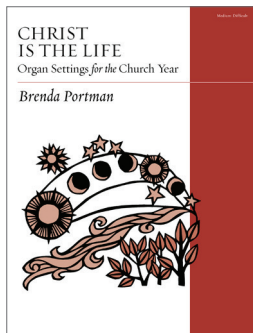
**Pull Out the Stops, Vol. 3:

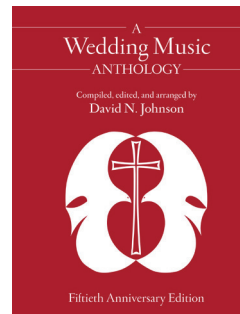

In celebration of the 150th anniversary of F. Melius Christiansen's birth, this anthology collects the best of his free works for organ along with transcriptions of his choral anthems.



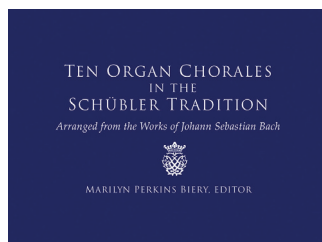
**Christ Is the Life: Organ Settings

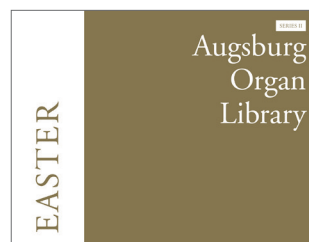
**A Wedding Music Anthology:
